## SYLLABUS

On March 16, 1973, the Judicial Inquiry Board filed a complaint with the Courts Commission, alleging that the respondent was physically or mentally unable to perform his judicial duties as evidenced by the respondent's failure to perform judicial duties and

his absence from his office during the periods from May 11, 1971 through September 13, 1971, and from July 25, 1972 to the date of filing this complaint, and as further evidenced by the findings of a physical and psychiatric examination of the respondent, conducted on January 3, 1973, at the request of the Judicial Inquiry Board. The respondent resigned from judicial office prior to a hearing by the Courts Commission.

Held: Complaint dismissed.
